

AURÉLIEN GALLET 10C MASTER SUITE

Born in France, Aurélien Gallet creates ultraluxurious interiors that seamlessly blend adventurous artwork, antiques, and contemporary furniture. He furnished the space with a pair of alabaster-and-steel lamps, artwork by Jean Michel Basquiat, and walls upholstered in a rich,

textured fabric. The most unusual piece in the space was a 1930s prototype for a medical chair, from Gallet's personal collection. "I wanted to create an intimate space, both masculine and feminine, that would feel like an enveloping retreat from the madness of the city," he says.



The walls of the master suite are upholstered in Stark fabrics. A pair of sconces from Wyeth on either side of Jean Michel Basquiat's *Aouphilia* from Tony Shafrazi Gallery. Alabaster-and-steel lamps from Maison Gerard Ltd. flank the bed.
